Green Roof Garages Initiative

Green roof owners enjoy increased property values of 15-20%, improved insulation, energy conservation, and on-site storm water reduction. The goal is to start small and add green roof covers to 25% of all front garages on their street (10-15 minimum) while educating homeowners on the benefits of green roofs.

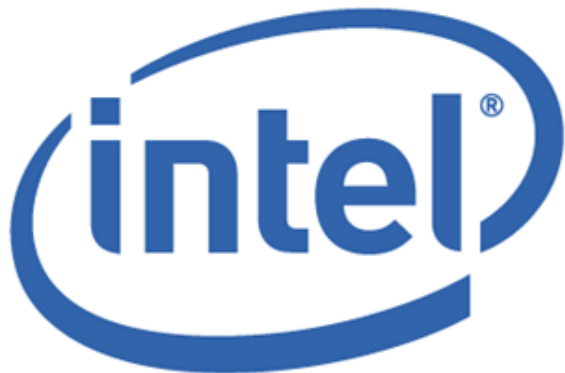
